

Although the **General Election** seems like a lifetime ago, I would like to say thank you to everyone who supported me on 7th May and helped me increase my majority to over 6,000. It is a privilege to be your MP and I will continue to work hard for all those who live in Carmarthen West & South Pembrokeshire, regardless of how they voted.

Since the Election we have also seen the **first Conservative budget in 19 years**.
